## Madison County Farm Bureau Federation Scholarship Application

### Eligibility

The Madison County Farm Bureau Scholarship fund will award 2 Regular memberships scholarships, 1 Associate member scholarship and 1 Agriculture scholarship to high school seniors for the current school year. Scholarships may be applied to housing, tuition, and other educational expenses. Payments will be made directly to the student, when proof of admission is submitted to the Treasurer of Madison County Farm Bureau Federation.

To be eligible, applicant must:

Have a minimum 2.0 cumulative GPA (on 4.0 scale)
Be the child of a Madison County Farm Bureau member
and remain such while the scholarship is in force.
Finish high school within the year they apply for the scholarship

#### Rules

Recipient may enter any accredited college or trade school; bust must pursue a 2-4 year course of study.

Recipient must enter college as a beginning freshman no later than the fall semester following high school graduation, unless a circumstance beyond the student's control, such as serious illness or injury, prevents enrollment at that time. In such a case, recipient must enter college by the spring semester of the following year of the scholarship.

Dropping out of school, except for serious illness or injury, shall cause the recipient to lose the scholarship.

Winner must be a full-time student each semester unless exception is requested and approved.

Winner is required to submit a school schedule of registration each semester unless an exception is requested and approved.

All application materials must be postmarked by April 7, 2017, or hand delivered by that date to Madison County Farm Bureau P.O. Box 998, Richmond, KY 40476 or in person at any Madison County Farm Bureau office.

The scholarship committee along with the board of directors will make the final determination on all cases concerning the interpretation of these rules. All applications become the property of the Madison County Farm Bureau Federation and will not be returned.

### MADISON COUNTY FARM BUREAU SCHOLARSHIP

The Madison County Farm Bureau Federation sponsors four (4) \$1000.00 scholarships to graduating seniors each year. Students eligible must have a 2.0 standing or higher, plan to attend college this fall, and your parents/guardian must be a member of the Madison County Farm Bureau Federation.
