### **MCFB <u>Recipe</u> <u>Corner</u> Cattle Drive Casserole**

- 1 <sup>1</sup>/<sub>2</sub> pound ground beef
- $\frac{3}{4}$  c onion, diced 1 bell pepper, diced 1 taco seasoning
- packet
- $\frac{1}{2}$  c sour cream •  $\frac{1}{2}$  c mayonnaise
- 1 c cheddar cheese,
- shredded

• 1 small can (4 oz)

- diced green chilies 1(10 oz) can Rotel diced tomatoes with green chilies 2 c bisquick
- 1 <sup>1</sup>/<sub>4</sub> c water, divided


Preheat oven to 350 degrees, brown ground beef, drain off grease. Add in diced onion, bell pepper, taco seasoning and  $\frac{1}{2}$  c of water to pan. Simmer approximately 10 minutes until union and pepper are softened.

In separate bowl, combine sour cream, mayonnaise,  $\frac{1}{2}$ c cheddar cheese and green chilies, set aside.

Stir Bisquick and <sup>3</sup>/<sub>4</sub> c water to make a soft dough. Spray 13x9 baking pan with non-stick spray. Press dough into bottom of pan and bake 5 minutes.

On top of biscuit layer, spread ground beef mixture, next add can of Rotel spreading over ground beef mixture, next spread the sour cream mixture and end with remaining shredded cheese sprinkled over the top.

Bake 30 minutes
