Legislative Report No. 2 2020 Kentucky General Assembly

Today marks the fourth legislative day of the 2020 Session of the Kentucky General Assembly. In the first four days of the session there have been a total of 114 senate and 273 house bills and resolutions filed.

On Tuesday evening, January 14, Governor Beshear will present his State of the Commonwealth address and on January 28, he will present his budget for fiscal years 2021-2022 to a joint session of the General Assembly.

up a meeting with them to discuss issues affecting agriculture and to present them with a Food Check-Out Day basket.

Special Elections:

On January 14, there will be a special election to fill the vacancy in State Senate District 38. Senate District 38 includes Bullitt County and part of Jefferson County.
