Using funding through the Kentucky Agricultural Development Board, the Kentucky Water Resources Board is seeking applications for projects that address water management on farms. The program seeks to:

- Implement Water Quantity Best Management Practices (BMP)
- Develop Innovative NEW Practices
- Adapt old practices to a new use
- Assess the economic feasibility and long term viability of new or existing BMPs
- Share results through publications, farm field days, or public tours

The program contains 2 project categories:

Research, Development, and Demonstration Farms (RDD)

- Water management projects on public, regional farms
- Involving multiple practices
- Made available for public tours, inquiries
- Up to \$250,000 per project

Practical Implementation Projects (PIP)

- Private farms wishing to implement best management practices for water quantity
- Up to \$50,000 per project


